

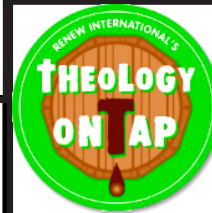

WHO ARE YOU FOLLOWING?**

**August 12, 2018 - "Who are You Following?"
Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time**

1 Kgs 19:4-8 / Eph 4:30-5:2 / Jn 6:41-51

Sometimes we just get tired. Life is difficult and we run out of steam. That is where we find Elijah in today's first reading. He is exhausted and ready to give up. It might be difficult to believe that a prophet would lie down and beg for death, but we have to understand that even the prophets were human beings -- susceptible to suffering and weariness. So an angel visited Elijah and brought him food and drink, and we learn that he ate and drank and was "strengthened by that food" and was able to complete his journey to Mt. Horeb. In our own times of weariness, we must remember the angel's words: "Get up and eat, else the journey will be too long for you!" By attending Mass, visiting our Lord in Adoration, or spending time in prayer, we receive. Stewardship is not only about giving; it is also about receiving God's gifts that gives us strength for the journey.
