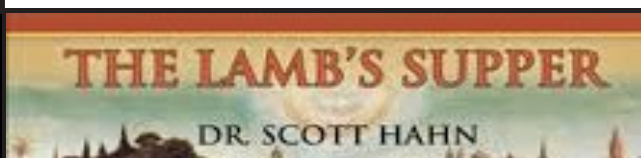
All in coming PSR Freshman and at least one parent need to attend a mandatory information meeting on September 12th at 7:30p in the Trinity Catholic Auditorium.
