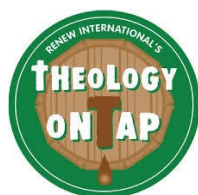

**Twenty-fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time**  
Is 50:5-9a / Jas 2:14-18 / Mk8:27-35

In today's Gospel we see the awkward scene where Jesus rebukes Peter, saying, "Get behind me Satan. You are thinking not as God does, but as human beings do." This seems harsh because Peter was simply speaking out against something that truly offended and saddened him -- he certainly was not trying to play the part of Satan! But how often do we let our fears get in the way of God's plans? How often do we shy away from proper stewardship of our gifts because we don't have faith?? In today's second reading, James says that faith without works "is dead." As missionary disciples, we should strive for a LIVING faith that does not doubt or fear, and joyfully cooperate with God's plans and ask for the faith and the courage to do so!

**THE LAMB'S SUPPER  
DR. SCOTT HAHN**

**The Lamb's Supper, the Mass and the Apocalypse.

Scott Hahn is one of my favorite Catholic theologians, and in one sense he and I have something in common. Many years ago, before either of us became Catholic, we both were caught up in the craze over the eminent worldwide "rapture" that so captivated the protestant world, inspired by the "Left Behind" book series, and the movies that followed. Hal Lindsay had come out with the book, "The Late Great Planet Earth", that sold thirty million copies, warning of the soon coming end of world. It was translated into several languages, and the basis for all of that uproar was his, and many others, interpretation of the Book of Revelation, the last book of the Bible. The rapture still captivates people today. Since that time both Scott and I have become Catholic, and the world did not end in the 70s. So, what is the Book of Revelation about? That is what our next exciting class is all about, and we will discover Scott's study of the Book of Revelation is the very reason he became Catholic. This class will run for several weeks, revealing the real meaning of this last book of the Bible, and Scott's stunning discovery of the Catholic Mass in this often-misunderstood sacred scripture. Scott's love of the Mass yet today, started in his intense study of Revelations, ultimately leading him to become Catholic.
